For the patriotic at heart, the conservatory has a display of the Stars and Stripes while a reflective pond showcases a Bald Eagle. Artisans will simply love the botanical variation of some well known works like one by Armand Guillaumin. A large brush and palette complete a fantastic background for this gigantic floral reproduction.

Seasonal Attractions

The entire appearance of the conservatory changes in line with the various seasons. In the winter months, the whole area is transformed into a winter wonderland with polar bears and penguins. A recent winter season exhibit included a 45 foot tall Shasta Fir tree decked with ornaments and candles. Choreographed lights added a dramatic effect to the entire exhibit much to the joy of the numerous holiday season tourists who walked in here.

Admission to the Conservatory

If you are planning a visit to Las Vegas soon, then you could include a stop at this conservatory to your itinerary. During the summertime, the exhibit is open on all days of the week, day and night and all members of the public are invited to feast their eyes on the stunning displays here.
